In Celebration Of The 15th Anniversary Of “Arts *Is* Education” And Designating
The Month Of March, 2015 As
Youth Art Month

WHEREAS, every year, the month of March has been declared National Youth Month across the United States; and

WHEREAS, March 2015 is also the 15th anniversary of Art *IS* Education, a countywide initiative to promote the integration of arts into public education; and

WHEREAS, the Emery Unified School District and the Emeryville Artists Cooperative sponsor programs to promote Youth Art through their curriculum and the Emeryville Youth Art “Artist in the Community” and “Artist in Residence” programs; and

WHEREAS, this is the 31st year that the cooperative venture between the School District and the Emeryville Artists Cooperative has provided youth related art instruction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville wishes to publicly recognize and support these youth art programs, its students, artists, and instructors; and

WHEREAS, these programs enrich our City, residents, and business community,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ruth Atkin, Mayor of Emeryville, on behalf of the Emeryville City Council, do hereby proclaim the month of March, 2015 as “Youth Arts Month”, in recognition of the 15th anniversary of the Art *IS* Education initiative and in affirmation of the City of Emeryville’s commitment to youth art education and youth art programs.
