SUBJECT: Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Supporting The San Francisco Children's Outdoor Bill Of Rights And Referring The Adopted Resolution To The Parks And Recreation Committee

### BACKGROUND

At the May 20, 2025, City Council meeting, Vice Mayor Kaur requested and received majority support for a resolution supporting the San Francisco Children's Bill of Rights.

### DISCUSSION

On October 18, 2014, the City and County of San Francisco adopted Resolution No. 81-15 recognizing the inauguration of the San Francisco Children's Outdoor Bill of Rights (Attachment A).

Adoption of this resolution by the City Council is a policy statement and it is recommended that the resolution, if adopted, be forwarded to the Park and Recreation Committee for any further discussion.
