

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Maintenance Contract With CleanStreet, Inc. In An Amount Not To Exceed \$50,680 For Street Sweeping Of City Owned Streets For Fiscal Year 2018-19.**

**WHEREAS**, the City contracts for the sweeping of all City owned streets; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 20, 2017, the City Manager entered into a Maintenance Contract with CleanStreet Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$44,917 for street sweeping of City owned streets for FY 2017-18; and

**WHEREAS**, said contract was approved following a Request for Proposal (RFP) process in June 2017 with the intention of using the selected vendor for five additional fiscal years; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed total contract amount for FY 2018-19 is \$50,680 with the inclusion of \$1,000 for on-call and emergency clean-up services; and

**WHEREAS**, the total contract amount contains a Cost of Living Adjustment based on the local Consumer Price Index of 3.6%, as provided for in the RFP; and

**WHEREAS**, there is sufficient funding included in the approved Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2018-19 to cover the cost of street sweeping; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the City Manager to enter into a Maintenance Contract with CleanStreet Inc., attached, in an amount not to exceed \$50,680 for street sweeping of City owned streets for FY 2018-19.

**ADOPTED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville at a regular meeting held June 5, 2018.
