SUBJECT: **Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Accepting The MacArthur Boulevard Full Trash Capture Project, (CIP Project No. 18475009), As Complete And Authorizing The City Engineer To File A Notice Of Completion With The Alameda County Clerk**

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the above-entitled resolution.

BACKGROUND

The MacArthur Boulevard Full Trash Capture Project was a Capital Improvement Program project, CIP #18475009, with the purpose of constructing a full trash capture hydrodynamic separator serving both Emeryville and Caltrans rights-of-way. The site is located along the north side of MacArthur Boulevard between Emery and Hollis Streets.

On June 15, 2021, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 21-67 authorizing the City Manager to accept \$680,000 in Cooperative Implementation Agreement funding from Caltrans towards this project and determined that the Project is categorically exempt from California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") review. On July 5, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22-90 authorizing the City Engineer to advertise for public bids for the project.

The project construction contract was advertised on September 6, 2022, and bids were opened on September 27, 2022. A total of six bids were submitted and received by the City. On October 18, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22-134 authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract with KJ Woods, Inc. (See Exhibit A) to construct the device. Construction was delayed by severe winter weather but was completed and functioning in May 2023.

DISCUSSION

The project is complete and ready for acceptance by the City Council, and the City Engineer must now file a Notice of Completion with the Alameda County Clerk.

FISCAL IMPACT

There are no additional fiscal impacts anticipated. Future maintenance costs of the project area are included in the operating budget.

STAFF COMMUNICATION WITH THE PUBLIC

There was no significant, non-routine staff communication with the public.


