1. Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee

Created: August 1, 1995

Official Action(s): Resolution No. 95-139; Resolution No. 03-55 (increased membership from 11 to 13); Resolution No. 06-228 (reduced membership from 13 to 10); Resolution No. 10-15 (increased membership from 10-14). Resolution No. 15-20 (became an independent community advisory committee rather than a Transportation Committee sub-committee)

Definition/Purpose: Advisory – Standing: Provides input and recommendations regarding City policies, priorities, and feedback related to the City's Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan and related initiatives.

Term(s): 2 Years, expiring on June 30th

Eligibility Requirements/Composition: 2 members from bicycle or pedestrian advocacy organizations who live or work in Emeryville and up to 5 members who are bicyclists or pedestrians who live or work in Emeryville for a total of 7 members.

Regular Meetings: 1st Monday of January, March, May, July, September, November, 5:30 p.m., Civic Center, 1333 Park Avenue
