Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Extending The Current Term For The Resident Position On The ACTC's Paratransit Advisory And Planning Commission To March 4, 2025; Amending And Publicly Noticing FPPC Form Number 806 As Required By FPPC Regulation 18705.5; And Amending The 2025 City Roster Of County, Regional And Statewide Bodies Accordingly

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22-165, whereby appointing John Suter as Resident on the Alameda County Transportation Commission's Paratransit Advisory and Planning Commission ("Commission") for a term ending December 31, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 10, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 24-143, whereby extending the current term of the Commission to January 21, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Clerk's Office opened a recruitment for the Commission's pending vacancy on December 20, 2024, and will appoint a new representative at their meeting on March 4, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the current assignment that is set to expire on January 21, 2025, would need to be extended to March 4, 2025, in order to accommodate the recruitment; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 21, 2012, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 12-146 thereby directing the City Clerk to complete and publicly notice the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") Form No. 806 of City representatives appointed to compensated positions on county, regional and statewide bodies, as required by FPPC Regulation 18705.5, and accordingly all Council Members may participate in a decision to appoint a representative to a compensated position; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the current term for the Resident position on the Alameda County Transportation Commission's Paratransit Advisory and Planning Commission is hereby extended to March 4, 2025; and, be it, further

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville directing the City Clerk to amend and publicly notice FPPC Form No. 806 as required by FPPC Regulation 18705.5 disclosing the appointment of City representatives to compensated positions on county, regional and statewide bodies; and, be it, further

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the 2025 City Roster of County, Regional and Statewide Bodies is hereby amended with the aforementioned appointments.
