



Planning Commission Interview Questions

City Council will be conducting interviews of the applicants prior to appointing a new Planning Commissioner. Below, you will see the select questions you will be asked during the interview. Please note that each interview will be approximately 15-20 minutes, with 2 minutes each allocated for your personal statement and interview questions. Any remaining time will be allocated for any follow-up questions by the City Council.

1. Short Personal Statement:

Why are you interested in serving on the City's Planning Commission? In your response, please include a summary of your relevant education, skills and experience, including any past civic involvement.

- 2. What do you see as the role of a Planning Commissioner?
- 3. Describe your knowledge of the City's General Plan and any other major planning documents that have been adopted by the City Council in the past two years.
- Give one example of a recent economic development or housing project in Emeryville that exemplifies your point of view regarding design, community benefit, and/or community process. Please explain why.
- 5. Follow-Up questions from City Council (moderated by the Mayor).
