

RESOLUTION NO. 23-102**Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Removing The Police Chief Position From Representation By The Confidential Administrative, Managerial, And Professional Employees (CAMP) Employee Organization To Unrepresented**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Management of Emeryville Services Authority (MESA) recognized the Confidential, Administrative, Managerial, and Professional Employees (CAMP) Association, which included the Police Chief job classification on December 7, 2010, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville (the "City") has previously adopted and periodically amended the Unrepresented Employees Pay and Benefit Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Management of Emeryville Services Authority (MESA) approved removing the Police Chief from its representation;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Emeryville City Council approves the placement of the Police Chief into the Unrepresented Employee group subject to the Unrepresented Employee Pay and Benefit Plan effective August 1, 2023.
