**Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Accept And Expend A Grant From The CHP Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP) To The Police Department In The Amount Of \$67,087.20 For Reducing Impaired Driving And Improving Traffic, Bicycle, And Pedestrian Safety Within The City And Increase The FY25/26 Budget By \$67,087.20**

**WHEREAS**, the California Highway Patrol (CHP) Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP) has awarded the City of Emeryville a grant in the amount of \$67,087.20 for traffic safety education and enforcement programs within the City to continue the Police Department's education and enforcement of traffic laws related to impaired driving, and improving bicycle and pedestrian safety within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, increasing available resources and staff time aimed at improving the safety of the motoring public, reducing collisions, and increasing safety for bicycling and pedestrian communities when public funding is available has been shown to be an effective tool; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funding received will be used to fund personnel overtime, enforcement, outreach and equipment to increase the Police Department's efforts in reducing driving under the influence/driving under the influence of drugs (DUI/DUID); and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department is requesting that the department's revenue account (254-53650) be adjusted to account for the increase of \$67,087.20, the equipment expenditure account (254-71050) be adjusted to \$10,288.20 to accommodate equipment purchasing, and the overtime expenditure account (254-91519) be adjusted by \$56,799 to accommodate the projected overtime expenditures; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville whereby authorizing the City Manager to accept and expend a grant from the CHP Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP) to the Police Department in the amount of \$67,087.20; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the FY25/26 Adopted Budget appropriates revenue of \$67,087.20 into the Grant Fund for the Police Department (account 254-53650) and appropriates expenditures of \$10,288.20 into the Grant Fund for equipment expenditures (account 254-91510) and appropriates expenditures of \$56,799 into the Grant Fund for projected overtime expenditures (account (254-71050).
