Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Purchase Four Marked Ford Explorer Hybrid Police Enforcement Vehicles In An Amount Not To Exceed \$239,249.68 From Folsom Lake Ford

WHEREAS, public safety requires that police personnel be provided with vehicles that are safe to operate and free of maintenance problems; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department sought a bid from the Ford dealer that was awarded the state bid contract, State of California Contract # 1-18-23-14B; and

WHEREAS, Folsom Lake Ford of Folsom has provided the state bid for the sale of Ford police vehicles and therefore this purchase is exempt from the City’s purchasing procedures pursuant to section 3-6.02(c)(2) of the Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, funds have been identified in the City’s Vehicle Replacement Fund (Fund 660) to replace Police Department patrol vehicles after five years of service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville to authorize the City Manager to purchase four Ford Explorer hybrid police vehicles from Folsom Lake Ford of Folsom in an amount not to exceed \$178,647.88 and purchase the needed emergency vehicle equipment at an additional estimated cost of \$60,601.80 and to appropriate said funds from Fund 660.
