**Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Service Agreement With Loomis Armored US, LLC, For Armored Car Services Not To Exceed \$6,000 Per Year**

**WHEREAS**, in April 2017 the City of Emeryville issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for banking services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City conducted a comprehensive selection process to identify a suitable financial institution; and

**WHEREAS**, Mechanics Bank submitted a proposal for banking services; and

**WHEREAS**, Mechanics Bank partners with Loomis Armored US, LLC (“Loomis”) to provided armored car service to provide cash transit services; and




