WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, the City Council approved the conceptual design of the 40th Street Multimodal Project and found it to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, in August 2022, the Public Works Department issued a Request for Proposals for "Professional Design Services for the 40th Street Transit-Only Lanes And Multimodal Enhancements Project" and after careful evaluation, City staff identified Diablo Engineering Group ("Diablo Engineering") as the most suitable consultant, considering their approach, experience, and understanding of the City's requirements; and

WHEREAS, in early 2023, Fehr & Peers (a subconsultant to the Diablo Engineering team) completed a traffic feasibility analysis as one of the first items of work for the design phase of the Project and the results of the analysis were shared with the Emeryville Transportation Committee on May 9, 2023; and

WHEREAS, there is need for additional work related to the unsignalized intersections, Staff recommends extending the design contract with Diablo Engineering to include Exhibit A-1 for a total cost of \$120,232.00; and

WHEREAS, tasks described in Exhibit A-1 include the preparation of final traffic analyses, environmental studies, and civil designs for the additional design work needed for the unsignalized intersections on the north side of 40th Street; and

WHEREAS, the 40th Street Multimodal Project including Exhibit A-1 would be fully funded through various grant programs for Design and Construction Phases; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2023, City Council approved the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2023-2024 through 2027-2028 ("CIP") which included CIP No. SUT-05, 40th Street Multimodal Project Phase 2: Bay Trail Gap Closure; and

WHEREAS, 40th Street Multimodal Project Phase 2: Bay Trail Gap Closure is aligned with local planning efforts and is consistent with goals and policies at the regional level with the Countywide Transportation Plan (from Alameda CTC), Plan Bay Area 2050 (from MTC), and Bay Trail Gap Closure Implementation Plan (from MTC); and

WHEREAS, combining the delivery of the "Phase 1" (CIP No. T-13) and "Phase 2" (CIP No. SUT-05) Projects represents an efficient use of Staff resources while also ensuring that the two phases are designed in an integrated fashion with ease and timeliness; and

WHEREAS, tasks described in Exhibit A-2 include the preparation of a final traffic analysis, environmental study, and civil designs for the "Phase 2" Project; and
WHEREAS , there is adequate budget in CIP No. SUT-05 to fund the tasks in Exhibit A-2; and
WHEREAS , the total amount of the 1 st Amendment Contract with additions of Exhibit(s) shall not exceed; now, therefore, be it
