

## INTERESTED IN SERVING ON ONE OF THE CITY'S BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES?

The City of Emeryville has numerous advisory Boards, Commissions, and Committees that help the City Council make Emeryville the best city the City can be. Every meeting is open to the public, with meeting agendas posted on the City's website: [www.emeryville.org](http://www.emeryville.org) as well as at City Hall, Police Building, Senior Center, and Hollis Street Fire Station. But to be a voting member of one of the City's advisory bodies, community members will need to apply and be appointed by the City Council.

<a href="#">Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee</a>	1 member who lives or works in Emeryville. City Council is scheduled to make appointments at the November 3, 2015 City Council meeting.
<a href="#">Commission on Aging</a>	2 residents: 1 for a term ending June 30, 2016 and 1 for a term ending June 30, 2019. Applications are due November 16.
Economic Development Advisory Committee	1 non-profit work force development organization representative; 1 large (56+) business representative; and 1 general business representative. Applications are due November 16,.
