

RESOLUTION NO. 18-152

Resolution Of The City Council Of the City Of Emeryville Authorizing the City Manager To Accept A Grant From The U.S. Department Of Justice, Office Of The Attorney General, Bureau Of Justice Assistance (BJA) Program, In The Amount Of \$67,500 To Upgrade The Police Body Worn Camera System ("Grant"), Execute The Funding Agreement For The Grant And The Grant Funds To Be Added To Fund Account 254-Grant Project Number 19254011 – Body Worn Camera

WHEREAS, the Emeryville Police Department applied for a grant from the U.S, Attorney General's Office, BJA Program, to assist in upgrading the Police Department body worn camera (BWC) system; and

WHEREAS, the need for improving the effectiveness and reliability of the body worn camera system is essential for the police officers to complete their core responsibilities, collect evidence, and to be accountable; and


WHEREAS, the DOJ-BJA grant public funding available has been shown to help law enforcement agencies by assisting in providing monies to agencies so essential tools, needed to perform their jobs effectively, can be acquired, and thus, authorizing the Police Department to utilize this grant funding to upgrade the body worn camera system to improve the collection of evidence, the storage of the digital media evidence, and to improve the accountability of staff is essential, now, therefore, be it


RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorizes the City Manager to accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of the Attorney General, Bureau of Justice Assistance Program in the amount of \$67,500 to upgrade the Police Department's body worn camera system ("Grant"), and to execute the funding agreement to accept the grant; and be it further


RESOLVED, the grant funds will be added to fund account 254 and the grant project number is 19254011 – Body Worn Camera.
