I am writing to formally request an extension of the current license agreement for the Insight Housing's Women's Shelter at the 4300 San Pablo Ave., Emeryville. Due to unforeseen construction delays the completion date for Insight Housing's facility in Berkeley has been delayed.

These delays have arisen from several factors beyond Insight Housing's control. Obtaining necessary building permits has taken significantly longer than anticipated, causing interruptions in the project schedule. Additionally, increased budget costs have required adjustments to our financial planning and project execution. To address these challenges and ensure progress, we have engaged an additional general contractor, who will be instrumental in keeping the project moving toward completion.

We remain fully committed to delivering this project successfully and are taking all possible steps to mitigate further delays. However, given these circumstances, we kindly request an extension of the license agreement to June 1, 2025 to accommodate the updated project timeline.
