Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Purchase Five 2023 F150 Lightning EV Trucks To Be Used For Emeryville Public Works Department In A Total Amount Not To Exceed \$273,904.45 From San Leandro Ford and to be paid from the Vehicle Replacement Fund 660-91200

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville's 2016 Climate Action Plan (CAP) 2.0 was written to make progress beyond the original 2008 CAP; and

WHEREAS, In accordance with the state of California targets, the City of Emeryville aims to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to 40% below baseline levels by 2030 and 80% below baseline levels by 2050; and

WHEREAS, in the CAP 2.0, Objective 16 of Local Government Operations is to reduce emissions form the City Fleet by 30%; and

WHEREAS, by authorizing this purchase and with the subsequent auction of legacy vehicles the Public Works Fleet will have a 28% reduction in its inventory of vehicles with internal combustion engines; and

WHEREAS, Alameda County executed a procurement agreement on September 23, 2021 for the purchase of vehicles from San Leandro Ford; and

WHEREAS, the California Public Contract Code 10298 allows the City to "piggyback" off of the County's agreement with San Leandro Ford such that the City can procure vehicles without undergoing normal procurement procedures required by the Public Contract Code and the Emeryville Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, by using the "piggyback" exceptions to procurement, the City can save valuable staff time while still benefiting from the pricing of a competitive process, as the City of Berkeley has already done; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorizes the City Manager to purchase five 2023 F150 Lighting EV Trucks for the Public Works Department in an amount not to exceed \$273,904.45 from San Leandro Ford and to be paid from the Vehicle Replacement Fund 660-91200.
