## **RESOLUTION NO. 23-118**

Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Execute A Sixth Amendment To The Professional Services Agreement With Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. For City Engineering & Inspection Services, Capital Projects Delivery Support, And Construction Management Services To Extend The Termination Date To June 30, 2024, With No Increase In Contract Amount

**WHEREAS**, on June 5, 2018, the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorized the City Manager to enter into a professional services contract with Coastland Civil Engineering Inc. (Coastland) to provide City Engineering services and capital projects delivery support, such as the Sherwin Williams redevelopment project and basic City Engineering Services; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 9, 2019, the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorized the City Manager to amend the contract in the amount of \$50,000 and extend the contract to September 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 15, 2020, the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorized the City Manager to amend the contract in the amount of \$359,100 and extend the contract to June 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 1, 2021, the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorized the City Manager to amend the contract in the amount of \$218,500 and extend the contract to June 30, 2022, and authorized the City Manager to execute amendments to further extend the termination date, amend the scope of work and to increase the contract amount by an additional cumulative amount of \$45,000; and; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2022, the City Manager executed a contract amendment for \$45,000 and extended the contract to June 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2022, the City Manager executed a contract amendment for \$241,479 and extended the contract to September 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, there is \$263,500 of remaining capacity in the existing contract; and

WHEREAS, there is no proposed increase in the contract amount; and

**WHEREAS**, continuing services are needed for City engineering, capital project support, and construction management services. The item before Council authorizes the continuation of the preexisting comprehensive contract with Coastland to provide additional needed services in support of the City's Capital Improvement Program through June 30, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing Coastland Agreement is to not exceed \$1,159,627. This work is proposed to be funded from the Design/Professional Services Component of the Capital Improvement Plan Project Budget. Some of the development review services will be cost

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recoverable; and therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the City Manager is authorized to enter into a Sixth Amendment to the professional services agreement with Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. to extend the contract termination date to June 30, 2024; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the City Manager is authorized to enter into minor amendments provided they do not increase the total compensation amount of the contract.

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor entered into a third amendment of the Contract on July 1st, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor entered into a fourth amendment of the Contract on July 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor entered into a fifth amendment of the Contract on February 16, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor desire to amend the Contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the public interest will be served by this Amendment.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

The Parties hereto irrevocably stipulate and agree that they have each received adequate and independent consideration for the performance of the obligations they have undertaken pursuant to this Amendment.

# 4. SEVERABILITY

If any portion of this Amendment is declared invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

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# 5. WAIVER

The City's failure to enforce any provision of this Amendment or the waiver in a particular instance shall not be construed as a general waiver of any future breach or default.
