Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Approve A Purchase Order With Independent Utility Supply In An Amount Not To Exceed \$982,930.04 For Lumec Materials For The Lumec Streetlight LED Retrofit, Project No. EPW 106-16, CIP No. 15475015; CEQA Determination Is Exempt Pursuant To 15301(c).

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program adopted by the City Council in June 2014 includes funding for the Lumec Streetlight Pole Painting and LED Retrofit, CIP No. 15475015 ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, to increase quality control and efficient management of the Project, the LED retrofit of the streetlights will be completed as a separate Project, before the streetlight poles are painted; and

WHEREAS, this Project includes the retrofit of existing Lumec streetlights throughout the City of Emeryville to upgrade the existing 100-, 175-, and 250-watt metal halide fixtures to 65-watt LED fixtures; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-6.02 provides that the purchase of supplies are exempt from bidding requirements in the supplies are available from a single source; and

WHEREAS, Associated Lighting Representatives (ALR) is the only local sales representative for Lumec branded supplies for the area; and

WHEREAS, in light of the quantity of supplies being purchased, ALR has negotiated a discounted price with their distributor, Independent Utility Supply, in an amount not to exceed \$982,930.04 and will furnish them to the contractor awarded the contract for the Project to avoid additional markups and minimize project costs; and

WHEREAS, by the City purchasing the supplies directly and furnishing them to the contractor, the City will avoid additional mark ups on the supplies, which minimizes the Project's costs; and

WHEREAS, the public interest would not be served by public bidding of said Project; and

WHEREAS, funding appropriated for the Lumec Streetlight Pole Painting and LED Retrofit, CIP No. 15475015, is sufficient to cover the above costs associated with the project; and now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, said Project is determined to be exempt under categorical exemption Class 1 Existing Facilities, State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c); and further be it Resolution Emeryville City Council September 6, 2016 Lumec Streetlight LED Retrofit Page 2 of 2
