Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A First Amendment To The Maintenance Contract With Matrix HG, Inc. Increasing The Contract Amount By \$23,000 To An Amount Not To Exceed \$67,948 For Routine HVAC Maintenance Of City Owned Buildings for Fiscal Year 2015-16.

WHEREAS, the City contracts for the maintenance of all City owned building facilities; and

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2015 the City entered into a Maintenance Contract with Matrix HG, Inc. (Matrix) on Concord, CA in an amount not to exceed \$44,948 for Routine heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) maintenance of City owned buildings for fiscal year 2015-16; and

WHEREAS, under said contract, Matrix provides routine preventive maintenance for all the City's HVAC systems. They also provide on-call repair service when the systems malfunction; and

WHEREAS, during the course of work in fiscal year 2015/16, more repair service was requested than was originally anticipated; and

WHEREAS, given all the extra repair work required in fiscal year 2015/16, an additional \$23,000 is needed to pay all invoices received; and

WHEREAS, the additional funds need for completing fiscal year 2015-16 will be charged to the existing budget for Capital Improvement Program Project No. 15650008 for General Maintenance/Facilities Replacement Program; and

WHEREAS, a First Amendment to the Maintenance Agreement for FY2015-16, increasing the contract amount by \$23,000 to an amount not to exceed \$67,948 is needed to pay for this additional service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a First Amendment to Maintenance Contract with Matrix HG Inc., increasing the contract amount by \$23,000 to an amount not to exceed \$67,948 for HVAC maintenance of City owned buildings for Fiscal Year 2015-16, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A",
