FIRST AMENDMENT TO

AGREEMENT FOR DESIGN, FABRICATION, TRANSPORTATION AND INSTALLATION OF ART WORK FOR THE SHELLMOUND/POWELL STREET BRIDGE PUBLIC ART PROJECT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO the Agreement for Design, Fabrication, Transportation, and Installation of Art Work at the Shellmound/Powell Street Bridge ("FIRST AMENDMENT"), is effective and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2016 by and between the City of Emeryville (the "City"), and R&R Studios (the "Contractor").

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 3 of the Emeryville Municipal Code ("Public Art Ordinance"), the City has allocated funds for the design, execution, and installation of Art Work for the Shellmound/Powell Street Bridge Public Art Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Artist developed a proposal to design, fabricate, transport, and install an original piece of art at Shellmound/Powell Street Bridge ("Project Site") as more particularly set forth in the Art Work Proposal submitted by Contractor pursuant to that certain Agreement for Art Work Proposal dated November 20, 2014 by and between the City and artist (the "Prior Art Work"); and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2015, the Emeryville City Council approved the Public Art Committee's recommendation to select the Contractor as the artist for the Project and authorized the City Manager to enter into an Agreement with the Contractor to design, fabricate, transport, and install the Project at the Project Site; and

WHEREAS, on April 11, 2015, the City entered into an Agreement with the Contractor to design, fabricate, transport, and install the Shellmound/Powell Street Bridge Art Work at the selected site and prepare the Shellmound District Public Art Plan ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 9.2 of the Agreement, the City was required to make Payment No. 1 to the Contractor upon execution of the Agreement as an advance payment for final design of the development and contractor fees for production of the Arts Master Plan Research; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.2 of the Agreement, Contractor submitted a proposed Final Design for the Prior Art Work and

WHEREAS, the Emeryville Public Art Committee (PAC) recommended to design, fabricate, transport, and install the Project as shown in the Final Design for the Prior Art Work; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2016 the PAC recommended the Project be stopped due to infeasibility of regular maintenance, as required by the Final Design for the Prior Art Work; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2016, the PAC further recommended Contractor complete the Shellmound District Public Art Plan; and

WHEREAS, at its June 9, 2016, PAC meeting, the PAC recommended to the City Council to enter into a revised contract to design, fabricate, transport, and install an original piece of art at the Project Site based on a submittal from Contractor considered at the meeting (the "Revised Art Work"); and

WHEREAS, the Contractor has substantially completed though not yet sought City Council approval of the Shellmound District Public Art Plan for which they are eligible for payment of \$33,000 under Payment #5 pursuant to Section 9.2 of the Agreement upon the Project Manager's acceptance of the Plan; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City and the Artist, for the consideration and under the conditions hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

- 1. The Parties agree that the foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference. The City hereby acknowledges that the Artist has satisfied conditions precedent for Payment #1 as set forth in Paragraph 9.2 of the Agreement and Paragraph 6 of this First Amendment. The Artist hereby acknowledges that the City has satisfied its obligations under the Agreement to date by making Payment #1 as set forth in Paragraph 9.2 of the Agreement and Paragraph 6 of this First Amendment.
- 2. Paragraph 2 of the Agreement, "Term of the Agreement", is hereby amended to extend the contract to June 30, 2017. The paragraph shall now read:

"The term ("Term") of this Agreement shall commence upon execution of this Agreement by the City and be completed no later than June 30, 2017, or on the Final Acceptance of the Art Work by the City Council whichever is earlier."

- 3. Exhibit A the Agreement is hereby replaced in its entirety with Exhibit A-1 attached hereto this First Amendment..
- 4. Exhibit E of the Agreement is hereby replaced in its entirety with Exhibit E-1 attached hereto this First Amendment.

5. Paragraph 3.3 of the Agreement, "Contractor Responsibilities" is hereby amended to extend the contract to June 30, 2017. The paragraph shall now read:

"The Contractor will be responsible for: (a) providing the City with the final design of the Art Work for approval; (b) a mock-up of the Draft Design indicating colors of tiles, colors and intensity of LED lighting and the interplay between the lights and the tile with a similar backing to the column surface found at the Project site as at minimum of three 12" x 36" samples) (c) fabricating, transporting, and installing the Art Work by June 30, 2017, (d) consulting the City on the Art Work; (e providing reports, documentation and description of maintenance requirements of Art Work; (f) securing all City permits for installation from the City; and (g producing the Plan as described in Section 3.1b above.

6. Paragraph 9.2 of the Agreement, "Interim Payment", is hereby amended to adjust payment increments under the Agreement. The paragraph shall now read:



The artwork simultaneously celebrates the multicultural character and bright technological future Located at the heart of Emeryville, THE SHELLMOUND DISTRICT GATEWAY welcomes pedestrians across the underside of the of the City of Emeryville.


The polychromatic art project introduces an exception in the urban landscape adding a note of color and joy to the bridge passage, THE SHELLMOUND DISTRICT GATEWAY transforms the bridge from visual barrier into an amicable space full of light, color and movement. The structural columns of the bridge are covered in multicolor glass mosaic tiles, adding movement and a kinetic effect to accompany and celebrate the bridge underside passage. The future Master Plan and public right away improvements will further enrich and sponsor connectivity between the Public Market and Bay Street. THE SHELLMOUND DISTRICT GATEWAY is realized in multicolor glass mosaic tile to ensure that the art project is maintenance free. In addition, the location of the art project at the bridge columns allows for project installation without traffic interruption in the area. LED lights illuminate the art project at night and develop a kinetic effect that brings life, movement and visual interest to the driver and pedestrian experience going across the bridge. THE SHELLMOUND DISTRICT GATEWAY brings a symphony of light and color to Shellmound Street and a unique experience for all to the City of Emeryville.



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





