RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EMERYVILLE APPROVING ARTISTS MARI ANDREWS, SOFIA CORDOVA, HEATHER DEYLING, JOSEPH KOSDROSKY, TATIANA MAK AND KEVIN WICKHAM, AND ALTERNATE ARTISTS KIM HARRINGTON AND CHRISTINA AGUILA FOR THE BUS SHELTER TEMPORARY ART PROGRAM – PHASE IV AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE APPROVED ARTISTS FOR FINAL DESIGN OF THE ART WORKS IN AMOUNTS NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000 FOR EACH ARTIST

WHEREAS, Article 4 of Chapter 2 of Title 3 of the Emeryville Municipal Code establishes the Contributions for the Art in Public Places Program ("Public Art Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, Section 3-2.404 of the Emeryville Municipal Code establishes the Emeryville Public Art Fund to implement the Art in Public Places Program; and

WHEREAS, a goal of the Public Art Program is to locate public art in distinct neighborhoods throughout the City and thereby introduce the City's public art to a larger audience; and

WHEREAS, as part of its 2016 project priorities, the Public Art Committee outlined the concept for Phase IV of the Bus Shelter Temporary Art Program with the intent to continue building the City's Art in Public Places Program through the installation of temporary works of art at transit locations, and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2016, the City Council approved the establishment of Phase IV of the Bus Shelter Temporary Art Program as part of the 2017-2021 Capital Improvement Program and appropriated \$75,000 from the Public Art Fund for expenses for artists fees and production of art work; and

WHEREAS, in July 2016 a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Phase IV of the Bus Shelter Temporary Art Program was issued and distributed to artists working in a wide range of media such as painting, photography, printmaking, textiles, metalwork and digital media; and

WHEREAS, the RFP requested that artists submit art for this program to continue the original program theme of "Flora and Fauna" to inspire compelling imagery as well as for the broad ranging possibilities for creative interpretation; and

WHEREAS, fifteen applications had been received from artists by the application deadline of September 2, 2016; and

WHEREAS, in August 2016 City Manager appointed a five-member selection panel for Phase IV of the Bus Shelter Temporary Art Program, comprised of Lauren Merker and Jean Camille Hamilton representing the Public Art Committee; Kristen Peterson

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representing the community; Zoe Taleporos representing the arts community; and Diana Keena representing the City (the "Selection Panel"); and

WHEREAS, the Selection Panel recommended that the following artists and alternates be selected for the Bus Shelter project: Mari Andrews, Sofia Cordova, Heather Deyling, Joseph Kosdrosky, Tatiana Mak and Kevin Wickham, with alternates Kim Harrington and Christina Aguila; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2016 the Public Art Committee unanimously endorsed the Selection Panel's recommendations on the artists and alternates and approved a motion recommending that the City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into agreements with the approved artists for final design of the submitted art work in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 per artist; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby approves artists Mari Andrews, Sofia Cordova, Heather Deyling, Joseph Kosdrosky, Tatiana Mak and Kevin Wickham (the "Approved Artists"), with alternate artists Kim Harrington and Christina Aguila, for the Bus Shelter Temporary Art Program Phase IV; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Agreements with the Approved Artists for final design of the submitted art work in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 per artist.
