Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Memorandum Of Understanding With The City Of Oakland For The Operation Of A Winter Shelter In The City Of Oakland For The Accommodation Of Up To 75 Persons For The Period Of November 14, 2016 Through April 17, 2017 In An Amount Not To Exceed \$30,000.

WHEREAS, due to the unavailability of the former Army Base homeless shelter, a new North County Winter Shelter Strategy was developed through a collaboration among Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville, Oakland and Alameda County; and

WHEREAS, the North County Winter Shelter Strategy provides 75 winter shelter beds in Oakland, ten of which will be reserved for Emeryville referrals, and 10 shelter beds at a secondary site in Oakland for vulnerable populations; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Emeryville and Oakland desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) describing how the City of Oakland will provide winter shelter beds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville appropriated \$30,000 in Affordable Housing Funds (Fund 299) in the Two Year Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 to pay for the provision of winter shelter beds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Emeryville and City of Oakland, attached as Exhibit A to this resolution, with respect to the provision of ten winter shelter beds for Emeryville referrals at the St. Vincent de Paul facility at 2272 San Pablo Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.
