Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Accepting the Urban Sustainability Directors Network Sustainable Consumption In Cities Grant, Authorizing the City Manager To Take Action Necessary to Receive the Award And Appropriating Said Grant Funds In The Amount Of \$6,108 To General Fund Account 4050-55300 To Develop A Pilot Program To Reduce Food Waste At The Emeryville Center For Community Life (ECCL) And In Community Services' Events

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville applied for \$6,108 from the Urban Sustainability Directors Network (USDN) through its Sustainable Consumption in Cities Grant program to develop a pilot program to reduce food waste at ECCL and in Community Services' events from the perspective of food procurement and green event planning ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, on January 4, 2017, the USDN awarded \$6,108 in grant funds to the City of Emeryville for this Project, with funding provided by the Global Philanthropy Partnership; and

WHEREAS, up to 40% of all food is wasted nationally, food waste prevention presents an excellent opportunity for reducing resource consumption and greenhouse gas emissions while shifting to more sustainable behaviors; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds must be spent by December 29, 2017; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby accepts the Urban Sustainability Directors Network Sustainable Consumption in Cities Grant Agreement, authorizes the City Manager to take actions necessary to secure the award, and allocate said grant funds in the amount of \$6,108 to General Fund Account 4050-55300 for the purpose of reimbursing the City for eligible expenses related to this project.
