Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville authorizing the Public Works Director to Submit A Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000) Funding Request To The California Department Of Resources Recycling And Recovery Beverage Container Recycling Grant Program (Cal Recycle) And Appropriate The Funds When Received To Fund 254 Project #01254105.

WHEREAS, The California Department Resources Recycling and Recovery provides funds to cities and counties for beverage container recycling activities; and

WHEREAS, eligible applicants to this grant program include cities, counties, or cities and counties in California, as identified by the California Department of Finance, unless otherwise determined by CalRecycle; and

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville is eligible to receive \$5,000 of these funds for beverage container recycling education activities, collection containers, and purchasing products made from recycled bottles and cans, and this year will use these funds to establish a comprehensive waste reduction educational program at ECCL; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code section 48000 et seq. the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) has established various payment programs to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the payment programs; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering payment programs require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the payment program.

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville desires to purchase equipment and services to increase recycling of beverage containers in the city and to promote recycling; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the Public Works Director to submit a \$5,000 funding request to the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery, pursuant to the Program Guidelines attached as Exhibit A, and appropriate the funds when received to the Fund 254 Project #01254105.
