



<p>Reason for Request: (Please explain in detail your request for funding. Why is this project needed? How will funds/project improve the quality of life for Emeryville residents?)</p> <p>We propose to create and install a cut tile mosaic mural for the outside fountain area nearest the Emery USD administrative offices (east side of courtyard). In the fountain's rear wall, measuring 4 feet by 9 feet, the design theme will be "Emeryville- Gateway to the Bay". This will feature a tableau of wetlands with grasses, reeds and native birds as Temescal Creek flows into San Francisco Bay.</p> <p>This project will transform a blank stucco wall seen by hundreds of students, staff and visitors into a beautiful depiction of Emeryville's natural world before its shoreline was extensively developed. Yet as abundant birdlife continues to return annually the mural demonstrates that with man's help Emeryville remains a haven for wetland inhabitants.</p> <p>Attached are photos of the proposed mural site and examples of mural designs previously installed by Mr. Lopez, the artist. These show a variety of birds and wetlands at La Escuelita School in Oakland. (continued on attached page)</p>
