Program/Activity Description

ECAP programs support at-risk families and individuals by providing daily food distributions, free clothing, counseling and other resource referrals for housing and personal needs. ECAP also assist families in surrounding neighborhoods with home issues like cleaning, personal relationship counseling, and providing food, clothing and basic needs. Often our work is instrumental in keeping families from entering Child Protective Services. We work with the surrounding community helping to keep our neighborhood clean. Our goals include establishing a computer lab to assist clients with job searches, designing resumes and preparing for job interviews. Additionally, we have started food preparation classes and our emphasis is on providing health food for clients. ECAP has revamped our clothing distribution, more effectively identifying and providing school clothes to families and distributing clothes to expectant mothers and their new babies.

As problem solvers, we continually find new ways to provide effective services to meet the individualized needs of the increasing client population. We will be collaborating with the family resource center in the new ECCL to enhance services for the families in the Emeryville Unified School District and throughout our community.

We depend solely on donation from corporations and individuals in Emeryville and surrounding areas, as well as the City of Emeryville providing a building and energy costs. **ECAP does not have any paid employees.** Mrs. Hannon and a multitude of other volunteers devote thousands of hours providing services to people who otherwise could not make it.
