**Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Professional Services Agreement With Sally Swanson Architects, Inc. In An Amount Not To Exceed \$154,798.00 For The Performance Of An ADA Access Compliance Survey For City-Wide Public Right-Of-Way And Facilities, And To Develop An ADA Transition Plan (CIP Project 17475010).**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA") (28 CFR Part 35) the City must take appropriate steps to ensure that individuals with disabilities are provided an equally effective opportunity to participate in or benefit from a public entity's aids, benefits, and services.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to perform an ADA access compliance survey for City-wide public right-of-way and facilities; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to develop an ADA Transition Plan for the mitigation of any physical barriers identified in the public rights-of-way and facilities covered in the scope of work.

**WHEREAS**, Sally Swanson Architects, Inc. of San Francisco, California submitted a proposal dated June 7, 2017 to perform said services for the proposed total contract amount of \$154,798.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that the Consultant is qualified by training and experience to render such services; and

**WHEREAS**, there is sufficient funding in the existing budget for Capital Improvement Program Project Number 17475010 using the General Capital Fund to cover the cost of this professional services agreement; and, now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville authorize the City Manager to enter into a Professional Services Agreement with Sally Swanson Architects, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$154,798.00 for the performance of an ADA access compliance survey for city-wide public right-of-way and facilities, and to develop an ADA Transition Plan.
