

RESOLUTION NO. 17-54

Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Appointing Council Members To Serve As Council Member Liaisons For Terms Ending December 31, 2017, And Amending The FY2016-17 Local Roster Of Boards, Commissions And Committees Accordingly

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to reinstate the practice of appointing Council Members to serve as non-voting liaisons to some of the City's Community Advisory Committees; and

WHEREAS, the Community Advisory Committees were polled to determine whether they were interested in having a Council Member serve in a liaison capacity and several indicated that they were interested; and

WHEREAS, given this feedback, the City Council determined that it was appropriate to appoint non-voting liaisons to five of the Community Advisory Committees, shown below; and

WHEREAS, the liaison appointments should be equally distributed among the five Council Members in order to evenly share the responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the liaison role is intended to provide a resource to the Committee and provide a conduit for two-way communication to the full Council, without attempting to influence the Committees' work, goals or priorities, and

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that Council Members are hereby appointed for a term ending December 31, 2017, as follows

Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee: **Council Member Medina**

Budget Advisory Committee: **Vice Mayor Bauters**

Commission on Aging: **Council Member Patz**

Economic Development Advisory Committee: **Council Member Martinez**

Public Art Committee: **Mayor Donahue**

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the FY2016-17 Local Roster of Boards, Commissions and Committees is hereby amended to include the aforementioned appointments.
