Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Third Amendment To The Professional Services Agreement For Audit Services With Lance, Soll & Lunghard, LLP, Increasing The Services Agreement Amount By \$123,663 To An Amount Not To Exceed \$881,718 For The Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Audit

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 10-16, the City of Emeryville entered into a Professional Services Agreement with Lance, Soll & Lunghard, LLP ("Consultant") as of February 2, 2010 ("Agreement") to engage Consultant for audit services for fiscal years 2009-2010 through 2013-2014; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2015, the City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into a First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for audit services for fiscal year 2014-2015 (Resolution No. 15-109); and

WHEREAS, on May 17, 2016, the City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into a Second Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for audit services for fiscal year 2015-2016 (Resolution No. 16-47); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to extend the Agreement for an additional one-year period for audit services for fiscal year 2016-2017; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that Consultant is qualified by training and experience to render such services, and Consultant has agreed to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, Consultant has submitted a proposal dated February 20, 2017, with the approved proposal attached and incorporated as Exhibit A to the Third Amendment to Professional Services Agreement; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the City Manger to enter into a Third Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for audit services with Lance, Soll & Lunghard, LLP, increasing the services agreement amount by \$123,663 to an amount not to exceed \$881,718 for the fiscal year 2016-2017 audit.
