WHEREAS, the South Bayfront Pedestrian Bicycle Bridge Project ("Project"), when built, will create an additional east/west route across the Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way for non-motorized traffic; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2017, the City entered into a Professional Services Agreement with EKI for \$37,000 to begin preliminary investigative work within the Project Site on the West side of the railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, additional work, beyond that anticipated within the original work scope, is required to comply with regulatory requirement for which EKI has proposed to do for an additional \$25,000; and

WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with EKI increases the total amount of compensation to an amount not to exceed \$62,000; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient funding appropriated as part of the Capital Improvement Program for the South Bayfront Bridge / Horton Landing Park project to cover the cost of said Professional Services Agreement; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a First Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with EKI in an amount not to Exceed \$25,000 for Environmental Sampling, Testing and Reporting Services at the site of The South Bayfront Bridge/Horton Landing Park Project, CIP# 16475006.
