Resolution Of The City Council Of The City of Emeryville Appropriating Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) From The Measure BB Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund 240 For 2018 Bike To Work Day (BTWD) Activities And Purchases

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville has received funds from the Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC) for the improvement of Bicycle and Pedestrian programs and facilities in the City of Emeryville; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a request from Bike East Bay for sponsorship of the 2018 Bike To Work Day Campaign; and

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville Transportation Committee and Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee have both recommended support of Bike To Work Day for at least 14 years, and this year both committees have again voted to support this campaign; and

WHEREAS, the City has sufficient funds to cover a \$3,000 contribution to Bike East Bay and \$1,000 for City staff expenses in the ACTC Measure BB Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund 240 for these items; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby appropriates \$4000 from the Measure BB Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund 240 for 2018 Bike To Work Day activities and purchases.
