

RESOLUTION NO. 18-14

Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville To Approve The Application To The California Office Of Traffic Safety (OTS), For A Traffic Safety Grant In The Amount Of \$102,522 And To Accept The Traffic Safety Funding If Awarded

WHEREAS, the Emeryville Police Department is applying for a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety to assist in increasing traffic safety within the City; and

WHEREAS, the importance of increasing the resources and staff time to improving the safety of the motoring public as well as to reduce conflicts and increase the safety of the bicycling and pedestrian communities; and

WHEREAS, the public funding available has shown to help law enforcement agencies devote more staff time to education and enforcement in areas where there is a higher propensity for vehicle collisions and injuries as a result of unsafe and impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the Police Department will utilize the grant funding to continue its education and enforcement of traffic-related laws related to bicycle and pedestrian safety to reduce injury and fatal traffic collisions, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville approves the police department applying for grant funding to the California Office of Traffic Safety for monies in the amount of \$102,522 and authorizes acceptance of the funding if awarded.
