**Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Adopting An Amended and Restated Emeryville Homeless Strategy**

**WHEREAS**, homelessness and housing instability have wide-ranging negative impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, individuals or families who are experiencing homelessness, or at risk of becoming homeless, are often unable to reach their full potential at home, at work, at school, or in the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the high cost of housing in Alameda County increases cases of homelessness and presents a barrier to its prevention; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 3, 2015 the City Council passed Resolution No. 15-10 adopting the City of Emeryville Homeless Strategy ("Homeless Strategy"); and

**WHEREAS**, the housing crisis has increased the incidence of homelessness in the region; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Emeryville is part of the Albany, Berkeley and Emeryville Housing Resource Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Emeryville is part of the North County Family Front Door; now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby adopts the Amended and Restated Emeryville Homeless Strategy attached as Exhibit A.
