Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The City Manager To Enter Into A Memorandum Of Understanding With The City Of Oakland To Fund The 2018-2019 Winter Shelter In An Amount Not To Exceed \$15,000

WHEREAS, due to the unavailability of the former Army Base homeless shelter, a new North County Winter Shelter Strategy was developed through a collaboration among Albany, Berkeley, Emeryville, Oakland and Alameda County; and

WHEREAS, the North County Winter Shelter Strategy provides up to 100 winter shelter beds in Oakland, five of which will be reserved for Emeryville referrals; and

WHEREAS, the Cities of Emeryville and Oakland desire to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding describing how the City of Oakland will provide winter shelter beds to people experiencing homelessness in Emeryville; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Emeryville and City of Oakland in substantial form as attached as Exhibit A to this resolution, with respect to the provision of five winter shelter beds for Emeryville referrals at the St. Vincent de Paul facility at 2272 San Pablo Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.
