# RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Resolution that declares the results of the Statewide Direct Primary Election held on June 5, 2018 as to the election for and against Bond Measure C.

# **DISCUSSION**

The Statewide Direct Primary Election was held on June 5, 2018 and the Alameda County Registrar of Voters' official canvass of returns has been completed.

On March 6, 2018, the Emeryville City Council adopted an ordinance ordering the submission to the qualified voters of the City of Emeryville of a proposition incurring bonded debt for the purpose of financing affordable housing projects at the Statewide Direct Primary Election. Passage of the Bond Measure required a two-thirds approval by the voters.

# CONCLUSION

The Registrar of Voters' Certificate of Results and Official Canvass is attached to this report and will be included as part of the Resolution required to be approved by the City Council to officially declare the results of the June 5, 2018 City of Emeryville Statewide Direct Primary Election.
