

RESOLUTION NO. 18-90

Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Appointing Celeste Burrows, Thomas Modic And John Scheuerman As Community Members To Serve On The Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee For Terms Commencing July 1, 2018, And Ending June 30, 2020; And Amending The FY2018-19 Local Roster Of Boards, Commissions And Committees Accordingly

WHEREAS, the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee is seeking to fill scheduled vacancies on the Committee for one (1) Business Representative, defined as a person representing a business in Emeryville of any size, and four (4) Community Members, defined as persons residing or working in Emeryville; and

WHEREAS, the vacancies on the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee were announced and noticed pursuant to the terms of Government Code Section 54970 et. seq. (the "Maddy Act"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council received applications from community members interested in serving on the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that Celeste Burrows, Thomas Modic and John Scheuerman possess the necessary qualifications to serve on the Bicycle / Pedestrian Advisory Committee; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that Celeste Burrows, Thomas Modic and John Scheuerman are hereby appointed as Community Members to serve on the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee for terms commencing July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2020; and, be it, further

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the FY2018-19 Local Roster of Boards, Commissions and Committees is hereby amended to include the aforementioned appointments.
