## EDYTHE BRESNAHAN BIOGRAPHY

I did my graduate studies in painting at the University of California Berkeley and continued to do post graduate work in printmaking for a number of years at California Collage of Arts and Crafts.

I am also a member of the Emeryville Artists' Coop and have maintained a studio there for 40 years during which time I have served on the board of directors and numerous committees. I also received an Artist in Residence Grant from the California Arts Council and the National Endowment for the Arts to work in the Emeryville high school district.

My paintings and drawings have been on view in various venues around the Bay Area, with several San Francisco galleries beginning with Dorothy Weiss Gallery, Cheryl Haines Gallery and the Triangle Gallery. I also have an affiliation with the Lora Schlesinger Gallery in Los Angeles.

I have been a professor at Dominican University of California, teaching all levels of drawing and printmaking. I served as the chair of the department for many years and retired Professor Emeritus in 2008.

In the last ten years, I have been traveling to Italy to study painting and have been very influenced by the Italian sense of design and glazing methods. The almost-white paintings in the Sienna series are really multiple layers of burnt sienna gradually getting lighter as they are applied to the canvas or panel.
