Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Declaring The Results Of The Emeryville Consolidated Statewide Direct Primary Election Held On Tuesday, June 5, 2018 As To The Election For And Against Bond Measure C

WHEREAS, a consolidated Statewide Direct Primary Election was held and conducted in the City of Emeryville on Tuesday, June 5, 2018 as to the election for and against Bond Measure C; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and legally given, voting precincts were properly established, election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished and in all respects said election was held and conducted by the County of Alameda, and the votes cast were received and canvassed and the returns thereof made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California governing Municipal Elections in General Law cities; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters of Alameda County, having canvassed the returns of said election, certified on June 21, 2018, a full, true and correct Statement of the Results of all votes cast at said election for each item, the result of which the Emeryville City Council accepts, and finds that the number of votes cast, the titles of the items voted for and other matters required to be as hereinafter stated; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that said consolidated Statewide Direct Primary Election was held and conducted in the City of Emeryville on Tuesday, June 5, 2018 in the form, time and manner as required by law, there were five voting precincts established for the purposes of holding said election and that the total number of ballots cast were 2,682; that the number of votes given in each precinct either for or against the measure, together with the whole number of votes which were received in the entire City are contained in the Alameda County Registrar of Voters' Certificate of Election Results and Official Canvass, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that, at said consolidated Statewide Direct Primary Election, Bond Measure C passed with the required two-thirds vote.



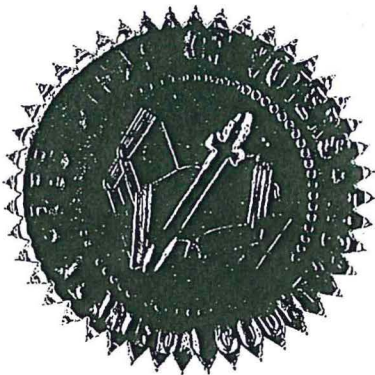
