Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing the City Manager to Execute a Memorandum of Understanding Between the City of Emeryville and the County of Alameda Public Health Department Regarding Provision of Education and Outreach for City's Smoking Pollution Control Ordinance and Rescinding Resolution No. 18-115

WHEREAS, Chapter 29 of Title 5 of the Emeryville Municipal Code, "Smoking Pollution Control" prohibits the smoking of tobacco and tobacco products in certain areas throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, on August 3, 2018, the City Council adopted the first reading of Ordinance No. 18-____, repealing and replacing Chapter 29 of Title 5 of the Emeryville Municipal Code to ensure that smoking of both tobacco and tobacco products, and other substances, such as cannabis was prohibited, and to ensure that all types of multi-unit housing was smoke-free; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2018, the City Council adopted the second reading of Ordinance No. 18-____; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Public Health Department-Tobacco Control Program (ACPHD-TCP) provides education and outreach to reduce smoking in Alameda County; and

WHEREAS, the City and ACPHD-TCP desire to partner to provide outreach and education regarding Ordinance No. 18-____ within the City of Emeryville; and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville, that the City Manager is authorized to execute the attached Memorandum of Understanding Between the City of Emeryville and the County of Alameda Public Health Department regarding provision of education and outreach of the City's Smoking Pollution Control Ordinance (Ordinance No. 18-____) and, be it, further

RESOLVED, Resolution No. 18-115 is hereby rescinded.
