WHEREAS, on November 17th, 2017, City Staff turned in an IDEA application to MTC for a proposed project that included a fusion of various technology-focused transportation elements to be deployed throughout the City of Emeryville ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, On February 14th, 2018, MTC's Programming and Allocations Committee selected the Project to be programmed and funded; and

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that the City Manager is authorized to execute the Funding Agreement for Innovative Deployments to Enhance Arterials (IDEA) Category 2 Project, A Supplement 1 to the Master Funding Agreement with MTC, and for all other agreements necessary to implement the IDEA Project.
