Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Declaring The Results Of The Emeryville Consolidated General Municipal Election Held On Tuesday, November 6, 2018 As To The Election Of Two Council Members, And The Election For And Against Measure S

WHEREAS, a consolidated General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Emeryville on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for the purpose of electing to office two City Council Members for full four-year terms; and

WHEREAS, at that same election, conducted in the City of Emeryville on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, was the election for and against Measure S; and

WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and legally given, voting precincts were properly established, election officers were appointed and election supplies furnished and in all respects said election was held and conducted by the County of Alameda, and the votes cast were received and canvassed and the returns thereof made and declared in the time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California governing Municipal Elections in General Law cities; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters of Alameda County, having canvassed the returns of said election, certified on December 6, 2018, a full, true and correct Statement of the Results of all votes cast at said election for each candidate, and for the outcome of the election on Measure S, the result of which the Emeryville City Council accepts, and finds that the number of votes cast, the names of the persons voted for and other matters required to be as hereinafter stated; now, therefore be it; and

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville that said consolidated General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Emeryville in the form, time and manner as required by law; that the number of votes given in each precinct either for or against the measure, together with the whole number of votes which were received in the entire City are contained in the Alameda County Registrar of Voters' Certificate of Election Results and Official Canvass, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that, at said consolidated General Municipal Election, Scott Donahue and Dianne Martinez were elected to the office of City Council Member of the City of Emeryville for a full four-year term, expiring in 2022.; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that, at said consolidated General Municipal Election, Measure S passed with the required 50% +1 vote.
