SUBJECT: Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Declaring The

Results Of The Emeryville Consolidated General Municipal Election Held On Tuesday, November 6, 2018 As To The Election Of Two Council

Members, And The Election For And Against Measure S

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Resolution that declares the results of the Consolidated General Municipal Election held on November 6, 2018 as to the election of two Council Members, and the election for and against Measure S.

DISCUSSION

The General Election was held on November 6, 2018 and the Alameda County Registrar of Voters' (ROV) official canvass of returns will be completed by December 4, 2018. The two City Council Members whose terms were expiring, thereby making their seats eligible for the election, were Scott Donahue and Dianne Martinez. Both of these incumbents sought re-election. One additional candidate, Ken Bukowski, filed nomination papers and qualified to run in the election. Preliminary results from the ROV's canvass of returns indicate that the newly elected Council Members are Scott Donahue and Dianne Martinez; the final canvass of returns will be certified by the ROV.

On July 24, 2018, the Emeryville City Council adopted a resolution ordering the submission to the qualified voters of the City of Emeryville of a measure to approve a business license tax on cannabis businesses, which became known as Measure S. The percentage needed to pass was 50% + 1. The ROV's preliminary results indicate that the measure has passed.

STAFF COMMUNICATION WITH THE PUBLIC

There was no communication with the public on this topic.

CONCLUSION

The Registrar of Voters' Certificate of Results and Official Canvass will be included with this report when presented to the City Council and will be included as part of the Resolution required to be approved by the City Council to officially declare the results of the November 6, 2018 City of Emeryville General Election.
