SUBJECT: Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing The Chief Of Police To Issue An Annual Cabaret License To Bank Club Cafe

#### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the City Council conduct a public hearing and thereafter adopt the attached resolution approving the Bank Club Cafe application for an Annual Cabaret License and authorizing the Chief of Police to issue said license for calendar year 2019.

#### BACKGROUND

The Bank Club Cafe Corporation is seeking an Annual Cabaret License to present live music entertainment at the Bank Club Cafe, 3900 San Pablo Avenue, during the hours of Monday through Saturday 11:00 AM to 02:00 AM.

The Police Department has investigated the Bank Club Cafe application and is recommending approval of the Annual Cabaret License with the listed Conditions of Approval included as part of the license.

#### DISCUSSION

Emeryville Municipal Code Section 5-4.03 provides that a license is required to operate a cabaret in the City of Emeryville. An application is submitted to the Police Department, which conducts a background investigation of the applicant and the proposed cabaret operation (EMC Sections 5-4.04, 5-4.06). At the conclusion of the investigation, the Chief of Police submits a report and recommendation on whether the requested license should be granted, and whether any conditions should be imposed (EMC 5-4.06). Thereafter, the City Council is required to conduct a public hearing to consider issuance of license and may impose conditions on the cabaret operation (EMC 5-4.07). The Annual Cabaret License expires on December 31 of each year, and an applicant is then required to apply for a new annual license. The Police Department has conducted the investigation and prepared this report with the following recommendations.

The concern regarding the issuance of an Annual Cabaret License for this location is the proximity to these residential buildings: Avalon Senior Housing, and Andante condominiums. The Police Department has not received complaints or concerns from residents at these locations. There were 11 Calls for Service to date in 2018, in or about

the location of the applicant address. These Calls for Service are not considered to be excessive or of a nature that would result in denial of this application. (See Attachment 1)

Staff recommends approval of this license application with the following conditions:

### CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- The Annual Cabaret License would be valid from January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019. Any Annual Cabaret License sought for subsequent years would require another application and an approval by the Emeryville City Council.
- The Annual Cabaret License if approved permits music to be played inside Bank Club Cafe and not on the exterior patio.
- All exterior doors and windows will be closed for the designated date and times of each cabaret event.
- Upon receipt of noise complaints during any cabaret event at Bank Club Cafe, Bank Club Cafe will immediately discontinue all music.
- Hours of operation for this Annual Cabaret License would be restricted to Monday through Saturday, 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.
- Bank Club Cafe shall be required to designate a contact person from Bank Club Cafe for all complaints from the public and to interface with the Emeryville Police Department. This contact person shall be made known to the Emeryville Police Department and all complaining parties upon request. The contact person shall be immediately available for all concerns or complaints.
- Any violations of these conditions or any listed in Emeryville Municipal Code 5-4.24 by Bank Club Cafe owners, managers, or employees may result in suspension or revocation of this Annual Cabaret License, pursuant to Emeryville Municipal Code Sections 5-4.08, 5-4.09.

The Emeryville Municipal Code Section 5-4.07 requires City Council Approval of every operation of a Cabaret within the City Limits.
