Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville To Accept Funding From The Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) Commercial Lawn And Garden Exchange Program To Replace Gasoline-Burning Landscaping Tools With Equivalent Electric Tools At No Cost To The City And Appropriate Said Funding To Grant Fund 254

**WHEREAS**, the City of Emeryville has adopted a Climate Action Plan 2.0 with goals to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 40% by 2030 and 80% by 2050; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Emeryville has opted to purchase 100% GHG-free electricity through East Bay Community Energy for municipal uses; and

**WHEREAS**, gasoline-powered landscaping equipment contributes to GHG emissions, while equivalent cordless, electric- and battery-powered, zero-emission landscaping equipment does not; and

**WHEREAS**, cordless, electric- and battery-powered, zero-emission landscaping equipment also reduces noise exposure to workers and noise pollution within the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has, through a Settlement Agreement with ConocoPhillips Company related to GHG emissions, offered an incentive program to provide grants to reduce GHGs and other emissions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bay Area Air Quality Management District has offered \$10,937.89 in grant funding to the City of Emeryville through this incentive program to purchase six cordless, electric- and battery-powered zero-emission landscaping tools and 18 batteries for the equipment, with the added requirement that the replaced gasoline-powered equipment be scrapped; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville to accept this funding and appropriate it to the Grant Fund 254.
