Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville The Community Grant Subcommittee's Recommendations To Select Kala Art Institute, Lead Artist Praba Pilar, New Arts Foundation, Friends of Golden Gate Library, Emeryville Historical Society, California Poets in the Schools, Inc., Scientific Adventures for Girls, Head Over Heels Athletic for Art, Berkeley FILM Foundation, The Oakland Public Education Foundation, Same Boat Theater Collective And The Oakland Ballet Company As The Recipients For The Emeryville Community Grant Program

WHEREAS, The Community Grant Program (CGP) was established almost twenty years ago as a means of "promoting the cultural and artistic aspects of the community and to provide for a high-quality living and working environment in the City of Emeryville; and

WHEREAS, staff developed an application process and guidelines which were accepted by the City Council on December 20, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the goal of the Community Grants Program which funds eligible arts and culture organizations and individuals to provide diverse programs and activities that benefits the greater Emeryville community; and

WHEREAS, on January 9, 2019, the City released a call for applicants with a February 28, 2019 deadline and received 16 applications; and

WHEREAS, a Community Grants Subcommittee of two Public Art Committee members and two Parks and Recreation Committee members were designated to review the applications; and

WHEREAS, the Selection Committee met on March 26, 2019 and reviewed the applications and recommends the City Council approve the Committee's recommendation and execute contracts with 12 applicants for implementation of their proposals; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby approves the selection of Kala Art Institute, Lead Artist Praba Pilar, New Arts Foundation, Friends of Golden Gate Library, Emeryville Historical Society, California Poets in the Schools, Inc., Scientific Adventures for Girls, Head Over Heels Athletic for Art, Berkeley FILM Foundation, The Oakland Public Education Foundation, Same Boat Theater Collective and the Oakland Ballet Company as the recipients for the Emeryville Community Grant Program in the following amounts:
