

Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Authorizing Expenditure In Excess Of \$45,000 For The Legal Services Provided By Jarvis Fay & Gibson, LLP

WHEREAS, the City's Planning Division has several development projects requiring legal support, including the Onni Project; and

WHEREAS, the demand for legal support exceeds the capacity of the current in-house legal staff; and

WHEREAS, Jarvis Fay & Gibson, LLP is a firm specializing in providing legal advice to public agencies on matters related to compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000, et seq.) and planning; and


WHEREAS, Jarvis Fay & Gibson, LLP is qualified by training and expertise to provide legal support related to the City's development projects; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that due to the scope of the Onni Project, Jarvis Fay & Gibson, LLP will provide legal services that cost in excess of \$45,000, but in an undetermined amount; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby authorizes expenditure in excess of \$45,000 for the legal services provided by Jarvis Fay & Gibson, LLP.
