**Why are you interested in serving on this Board, Commission or Committee?**

As a disabled veteran I moved to Emeryville in 2015. At the time I was experiencing worsening health and increasing mobility issues. Over time I have been able to reverse both, and the pedestrian experience in Emeryville specifically, and the tri-city area more broadly, has been highly influential in my rehabilitation. Though a city boy and native Californian by birth, I spent most of my life after a certain age living in lower-density areas, dreaming of returning to a place I could give up my car, walk out of my door, and enjoy the city life I had been so enamored of as a child. I last lived in this region in the 1980's with my poor single mother, in San Francisco, a feat hard to imagine today. I fell in love with transit as a young boy riding the light rail. This evolved into a lifelong love of train travel and a passion for the pedestrian- and transit-oriented living my life moved me away from for many years. Six years ago I returned to the Bay Area, this time to Oakland. I saw the framework of all the things I loved, but the dream of city life had become an increasingly inaccessible one. It is then that I started connecting to a newly energized urbanism movement trying to empower people of all ages to collect in an accessible, walkable, bikeable, transit-oriented, and above all, livable city. My natural zeal for the topic was always going to lead me to participation in government. If elected as a member of an advisory committee, I plan to do my part to help Emeryville open the door to this dream a little wider.
