June As Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, And Transgender Pride Month In The City Of Emeryville; And Approving The Raising Of The Pride Flag At City Hall For The Entire Month Of June Each Year; And Approving The Raising Of An Additional Pride Flag At City Hall in June 2019

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the above-entitled resolution.

BACKGROUND

At the City Council meeting on May 29, 2019, Council Member Bauters requested and received majority support to add this item to the June 4, 2019 City Council agenda for consideration.

DISCUSSION

The City of Emeryville has a history of commemorating June as Pride Month, as a way of recognizing the occasion and educating the community on the impact that the contributions of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender individuals have had on history locally, nationally, and internationally.

The resolution proclaims the month of June as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender Pride Month in the City of Emeryville. The resolution also authorizes the Pride Flag to be flown in front of City Hall for the entire month of June each year without additional action being necessary.

The resolution also authorizes raising an additional Pride Flag for in June of this year on behalf of the LGBT community in the region.
