

REGISTRAR OF VOTERS CERTIFICATE TO PETITION

I, Tim Dupuis, Registrar of Voters for the County of Alameda, State of California, hereby certify that:
A Referendum Petition Entitled: An Ordinance of the City of Emeryville Amending Sections 5-37.01 and 5-37.02 of Chapter 37 of Title 5 of the City of Emeryville Municipal Code with Respect to the Minimum Wage for Employees of Small Independent Restaurants. Petition was filed with the City Clerk of Emeryville within the statutory time limit and forwarded to this office for verification on June 25, 2019; and

The petition contained 885 unverified signatures; and

Pursuant to California Elections Code section 9215, in order to be sufficient, the petition must have been signed by 666 qualified registered voters of the City of Emeryville, that number being equal to ten percent of the total registered voters of the City at the last Report of Registration to the Secretary of State; and

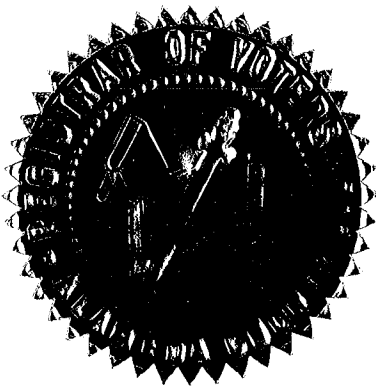
I have examined, or caused to be examined, signatures on the petition pursuant to California Elections Code sections 9211 and 9114; and

Have determined that the petition contained 871 valid signatures of qualified registered voters in the City of Emeryville based on the line by line examination set forth in Section 9114 of the California Elections Code: and

That this number represents the total number of signatures needed to qualify the initiative therefore;

The petition is found to be sufficient to require the City Council of the City of Emeryville to take the appropriate action specified in the California Elections Code.
