

RESOLUTION NO. 20-04

Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Emeryville Appropriating Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500) From The Measure BB Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund 264 For 2020 Bike To Work Day (BTWD) Sponsorship

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville has received funds from the Alameda County Transportation Commission (ACTC) for the improvement of Bicycle and Pedestrian programs and facilities in the City of Emeryville; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a request from Bike East Bay for sponsorship of the 2020 Bike To Work Day Campaign; and

WHEREAS, the City of Emeryville Transportation Committee and Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC) have both recommended support of Bike To Work Day for at least 16 years, and this year both committees have again voted to support this campaign; and


WHEREAS, the BPAC recommended sponsoring Bike to Work Day at the \$2,500 Bronze Level and donating an additional \$1,000 for a total of \$3,500, and subsequently the Transportation Committee recommended that the donation be made at the \$2,500 Bronze Level; and

WHEREAS, the City has sufficient funds to cover a \$2,500 contribution to Bike East Bay in the ACTC Measure BB Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund 264 for these items; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Emeryville hereby appropriates \$2,500 from the Measure BB Bicycle/Pedestrian Fund 264 for 2020 Bike To Work Day sponsorship.
